- 1) **Résumé:** Resume detailing relevant education and performance experience
- 2) Audio recordings demonstrating vocalist's musical & stylistic versatility including:
 - A) **A Capella rendition of the U.S. National Anthem**
 - B) **Stylistically Diverse Musical Samples:** 5-7 audio/video clips highlighting strengths and demonstrating stylistic knowledge of:
 - a. Rock
 - b. Pop
 - c. R&B
 - d. Jazz
 - e. Musical Theatre
 - f. Country

It is preferred that the musical samples be well recorded and performed with other musicians, or with "music minus one" style tracks. It is acceptable to include solo performances for some of the above styles, but please include as many group performances as possible.
